About the Boy Scouts of America and the STEM Program

The Boy Scouts of America (BSA) is proud to serve more than 4.6 million youth between the ages of 7 and 20, as the nation's foremost youth program of character development and values-based leadership training. The BSA movement is comprised of 1.2 million volunteers, whose dedication of time and resources have enabled the BSA to remain the nation's leading youth-serving organization. Locally, Scouting serves nearly 20,000 youth in Northern and Central New Jersey.

STEM (science, technology, engineering, and mathematics) disciplines are considered by many to be the foundation of an advanced society. To engage our youth members in STEM, the Boy Scouts of America created new program initiatives that emphasize STEM in the context of the current advancement programs, and currently we offer over 60 STEM related merit badges.

We have enhanced STEM content in every facet of Scouting from summer camp to the pinewood derby, by developing programs that explore the STEM principles behind familiar Scouting activities. The BSA's STEM initiative gives Scouts an opportunity to explore relevant skills and experiences and to be recognized for their achievements. The BSA partnered with institutions like MIT, Carnegie-Mellon and ExxonMobil to create new merit badges in STEM, Robotics and Inventing. The BSA's aim is to expose youth to new opportunities and help them develop the STEM skills critical for the competitive world marketplace.
