**Lot #4** 2-hours and 30-minute spaces, paid parking

**Lot #5** 90-minute and 15-minute spaces, paid parking

### Additional weekend parking

**Lots #6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, and 13**

FREE on Saturday and Sunday, no permit required.

No overnight parking in any lots without a Summit overnight resident permit.

### RESIDENT COMMUTER PARKING

**Lots #6, 7, 8, 9, and 13**

Daily parking fee: \$4 per day, Monday thru Friday

from 4am to 6pm, permit required

FREE on Saturday and Sunday, no permit required

Discounts available for quarterly & annual prepaid parking

### DOWNTOWN EMPLOYEE PARKING

**Lots #6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, and 13**

Daily parking fee: Monday thru Friday

from 4am to 6pm, permit required

FREE on Saturday and Sunday, no permit required

Discounts available for quarterly & annual prepaid parking

### DOWNTOWN STREET METER PARKING

Street meters are FREE on Sundays and certain Holidays.

All time limits and Fees are posted on meters.

### NON-RESIDENT COMMUTER PARKING OPTIONS

**Lot #13**, Broad Street East Lot, daily parking only, daily fee

required, no permit required. No overnight parking permitted,

FREE on Sat. and Sun. and certain Holidays.

**Lot #14**, Park & Rail, 24-hour parking up to 5 days,

daily fee required. FREE on Sat. and Sun. and certain Holidays.

**Lot #15**, Park & Ride (bus), \$3 per day to park

Prepaid discounts require a permit.

No overnight parking permitted.

### LIBRARY/YMCA LOT

**Lot #16** Monday thru Saturday, 8am-6pm

2-hour and 30-minute paid parking is available for Library and YMCA patrons only.

### PURCHASE A SUMMIT SMARTCARD

A convenient way to pay for parking without coins! Purchase a Summit Smartcard from the Parking Services Agency at City Hall in denominations of \$10, \$20, \$50 or \$100.

Recharge your Summit Smartcard with a credit card at the following locations:

- Broad Street Garage, Summit Avenue Pay Shelter (Lot #6)
- Tier Garage, ground level pay area (Lot #4)

Recharge your Summit Smartcard at City Hall Parking Services Agency during regular business hours.

DeForest Avenue gated lots do not accept the Summit Smartcard

### DOWNTOWN PARKING REWARDS COUPONS

Participating downtown businesses may reward their customers with a **DOWNTOWN PARKING REWARD COUPON**. Parking reward coupons can only be used in the DeForest Avenue parking lots. Each coupon must be inserted after the entry ticket in the Pay Station at the lot.

### PARKING PERMITS

To obtain a resident or downtown employee permit, applicants must submit the application with valid vehicle registration, include insurance card (if vehicle is leased). Downtown employees must have the owner or manager sign the application.

Summit residents must physically live in the Summit residence in order to qualify for a permit. New residents, please refer to the application for all information required. Forms and requirements are available at [www.cityofsummit.org](http://www.cityofsummit.org) or call 908-522-5100.

Overnight parking permits in the Business District are available for Summit residents only for a quarterly fee. Applicants must present a valid vehicle registration, insurance card, and copy of a current lease.

Permits are available for the Park & Ride (Lot #15) at the Parking Services Agency. Visit [www.cityofsummit.org](http://www.cityofsummit.org) for forms and mailing information. Applicants must present with application, a valid vehicle registration, insurance card, and payment.

### VISITOR PASSES

Contractors doing business in the Central Retail Business District should pre-purchase Daily Visitor Passes for long-term daily parking from the Parking Services Agency at City Hall. Visitor passes may not be used in the DeForest Avenue Lots.

### BAGGED METERS/DUMPSTER PERMITS

With 72-hours notice, downtown employers, utility companies and certain contractors may bag street meters or request a dumpster permit in the Central Retail Business District. Fees and restrictions apply. For information and pricing contact the Parking Services Agency at 908-522-5100.

Available at all municipal parking locations and at all street meters. At this time, no convenience fee applies to any customer using Parkmobile. DeForest Avenue lots can only use smartphones for scanning in and out of the lot.

### ENFORCEMENT

Parking Services Agency enforces all metered areas (on and off-street) within Summit's Business District to make parking available to the maximum number of people. Please adhere to regulations and parking time limits.

### HANDICAPPED PARKING

Downtown Summit has handicapped parking spaces available for drivers with a visible VALID handicap placard or plates. If a handicapped space is not available, you may park at any street meter or in any lot (excluding permit-required lot). Per NJ State law, (C.39:4-207). When parking at a metered space, the driver with a placard or handicapped license plate must put the appropriate amount of money in the meter. If the vehicle will occupy the space for more than the maximum amount that the meter holds, the driver must fill the meter to the maximum amount. If you are parked in the gated lots on DeForest you will pay the hourly fee for the entire time you are parked. In long-term lots you need to pay the daily fee and have permit, if required.

### PARKING HOLIDAYS IN SUMMIT

On annual parking holidays, New Years Day, Martin Luther King Day, Presidents' Day, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day, parking is FREE in long-term lots and at street meters. ### BICYCLE PARKING & LOCKERS

Complimentary bike racks are available for commuters and residents at locations on Union Place and Railroad Avenue sides of the Summit Train Station. Consider leaving your car at home and riding your bicycle.
